The following policy statement was adopted at the Mooloolaba Executive Management Committee meeting held on the 16th March 2011 as an official Club Policy.

INTRODUCTION

The Mooloolaba Surf Life Saving Club is committed to ensure the Members BBQ area is maintained and accessible to all members and its use complies with OH&S and Government Liquor Licensing Laws.

AIM

The aim of this policy is to provide some guidelines for usage of the Members BBQ area and to assist those responsible to meet legislative requirements and the Club's Code of Conduct.

USAGE

The usage of the area is limited to Active Members and their guests only. The Member booking the area is responsible for their guest's behaviour including ensuring they abide by the Club's Code of Conduct, Liquor Licensing Laws and other Club Policies. If the member leaves, all guests must also vacate the premises.

This Policy also includes but is not limited to:-

- The official Club BBQ Booking Form must be completed and signed and a credit card imprint of cash payment left as a bond. The bond required is currently set at \$100 however the Committee reserves the right to vary this amount from time-to-time.
- The area is a Club Members Area and therefore by booking the BBQ area this does not give you sole usage rights. Other members may share the tables, kitchen, grass etc.
- Maximum numbers limited to 20 only.
- Children are to be supervised at all times.
- Guests are required to be orientated with regards to use of Club premises including the fire exits, toilet facilities etc.
- Guests are limited to the Members grass area only and are not permitted in the boatshed, gymnasium or any other area than the BBQ/Members Area.
- Areas must be thoroughly cleaned after use including the removal of rubbish, cleaning the BBQ plate, cleaning the Kitchen, wiping down benches etc. NO food is to be left in the refrigerator. Failure to clean up the area will incur a cleaning fee of \$35 to be taken from the bond.
- Not under any circumstances is alcohol to be served to anyone under the age of 18
- Alcohol is not to be sold in any way
- BYO alcohol must be consumed within the grass area and any excess alcohol left over MUST be removed from the area
- Members are encouraged to purchase alcohol through the Supporters Club
- Any broken glass and spillage must be cleaned up immediately
- All attending must abide by the Supporters Club security or Duty Manager directions
- The area is a NON SMOKING area
- The member responsible for the function MUST be sober and in control of his/her guests

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INTRA-CLUB FUNCTION

Small member function i.e. after patrol BBQs etc are encouraged and most welcome. If this is an after patrol function, the Patrol Captain is responsible for the Members behaviour and to ensure the area is left as per the Club Policy.

The official booking form is not required for these type of intra-club functions however the Patrol Captain or Coach etc must be the nominated person responsible for the function and be aware of the Club BBQ policy.

The Club Captain, General Manager or another Executive Committee member must be advised of the function prior to it occurring.
